

Applications under pupil premia criterion

This application form is only to be completed if you wish to apply for priority under the pupil premia criterion. For priority to be given, the parent / carer will need to submit this application form and proof of eligibility.

Proof of eligibility can be one of the following:

- in the form of a letter from your child’s nursery / current school confirming they are receiving early years pupil premium, the pupil premium, or the service premium for your child.
- in the case of early years pupil premium, in the form of documents confirming you get 15 hours free childcare, and you are also receiving one of the following:
 - income Support
 - income-based Jobseeker’s Allowance
 - income-related Employment and Support Allowance
 - support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
 - the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
 - Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit) and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190
 - Working Tax Credit run-on, which is paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
 - Universal Credit - your household income must be less than £7,400 a year after tax not including any benefits you get.
- In the case of pupil premium, children who are:
 - recorded as eligible for free school meals, or have been recorded as eligible in the past 6 years
 - previously looked after by a local authority or other state care, including children adopted from state care or equivalent from outside England and Wales
- in the case of service premium in the form of documents confirming one of the following:
 - one of their parents is serving in the regular armed forces (including children with a parent who is on full commitment as part of the full-time reserve)
 - one of their parents died whilst serving in the armed forces and the child receives a pension under the Armed Forces Compensation Scheme or the War Pensions Scheme
 - they have been registered as a ‘service child’ on the January school census at any point since 2016

As well as completing this form, you must also list the Academy as a preference on your local authority's / council's application form.

- For applications for start Reception in September 2027, the deadline is **15 January 2027**.
- In-year applications can be submitted at any time.
