DROPPING OFF - KEY MESSAGES

Please ensure that you are adhering to social distancing guidelines and are 2m apart. Thank you for follow the orange dots when dropping and collecting your child. We need to sustain this when the weather deteriorates. We have limited capacity to supervise all areas of the playground and are grateful to all adults for acting responsibly.

Please ensure that you drop your child at the classroom bubble door each morning. Parents and carers must not leave children to walk unaccompanied beyond the green gate (canopy) as this means they are unsupervised on the playground which could pose a safeguarding concern. Thank you in advance for your understanding.
