### **Squid Game on Netflix**

It has been brought to our attention that some of our students have been talking about the TV series 'Squid Game' with a number saying they have watched episodes and mimicking 'games' or 'challenges' in the programme.

This programme is certified 15 and depicts sex scenes, nudity, extreme violence, self-harm, suicide and inappropriate bad language. It is not suitable for primary school aged children.

Watching scenes such as those above can have long-lasting, damaging effects on young children and cause long term anxiety.

Should we hear children saying they have been exposed to this series, we will continue to treat this as a safeguarding concern and will continue to speak to those parents / carers concerns and possibly seek advice from Children's Services if necessary.

Please be very vigilant about what your children are watching, especially if they have older siblings and family members who may watch these programmes.
