Dear families

I am pleased to inform you that we will be working with Bikeability to provide opportunities for students in Year 5 to develop their cycling skills. Bikeability's mission is to get more people cycling, more safely and more often. As part of this mission, we will be offering Level One training to all Year 5 students.

Level One training takes place in a traffic free environment; focusing on preparing the rider through appropriate choice of clothing, troubleshooting the bike, and is then followed by basic bicycle control skills, including starting, stopping, pedalling, negotiating space and signalling.

Students will take part in the training in groups of 15 under the direction of trained Bikeability professionals and school staff. The sessions will take place in the school playground over the course of two days: 8 and 9 December. Bikeability will provide bikes and helmets for the sessions.
