Dear Families,

We are pleased to invite you and your family to attend our upcoming **Community Iftar Evening**, taking place on **Wednesday 25 February**. This event has been arranged with the valued support of our **newly founded Parent-Teacher Association (PTA)** and has been organised to bring families together, strengthen community ties, and learn more about the traditions observed during the month of Ramadan. As this is a family event, all students must be accompanied by an adult and will be under supervision of families through.

Iftar is the evening meal with which Muslims break their daily fast at sunset during Ramadan. It is a time that emphasises reflection, gratitude, generosity, and community. While rooted in Islamic tradition, Iftar is often shared with friends, neighbours, and guests of all backgrounds as a way of fostering understanding and togetherness.

We would like to emphasise that this event is **open to all families and cultures**. Everyone is warmly welcome, and no prior knowledge of Ramadan or Islamic practices is required.

- **Date:** Wednesday 25 February
- **Time:** Doors open at **4:30pm**, with the fast breaking at approximately **5:40pm**. Doors close at **7pm**
- **Ticket price:** £5 per person (includes food provided by reputable local business)
- **Ticket availability:** First-come, first-served
- **Audience:** All families welcome

Food for the evening will be provided by a reputable local business. Please note that the link will expire on Friday 13 February to allow us enough time to communicate dietary requirements to our caterers. The programme will also include a performance by a local Nasheed artist, and dedicated prayer areas will be available throughout the event.

In addition, there will be a range of stalls operating on the night, alongside several fundraising opportunities. All funds raised on the evening will go directly towards supporting school initiatives and enhancing opportunities for our pupils. We are grateful to **Islamic Relief**, who are kindly sponsoring this event and will also have their own fundraising stall at the event.
