### **Key Dates for Year 6 Students**

The final days of primary school should be a memorable occasion for every Year 6 student and we would like to share these key dates early in Cycle 3 so that families can make arrangements. Please see below the planned dates for Year 6 at Dixons Music Primary:

#### **Friday 11 July: Cinema Trip**

Students will be going on a cinema trip to see the showing of 'Elio' at Cineworld Bradford. The film is 'PG' rated and there will be further communication around this in the next few weeks.

#### **Tuesday 15 July: Celebration and Red Carpet Events**
