## **Year 6 Behaviour Transition**

Dear families

In preparation for the transition to secondary school, the way behaviour reminders are issued in Year 6 is being adapted for the remainder of Cycle 3. The system used is similar to that at Dixons Trinity Academy and this will further support students in their transition to secondary school. Currently students who are not demonstrating our six learning habits first receive a teacher 'look', then a verbal warning and finally a 'p' code written in their planner. Two 'p' codes in a lesson, or three 'p' codes in a day result in a correction.

From Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June, the verbal warning will be removed for Year 6 students only, meaning that they will not receive a verbal reminder to correct their behaviour. Students are aware of this change. They understand that they are responsible for their own actions and that the academy values and learning habits should always be followed. A list of these can be found in your child's knowledge organiser folder.
