We are delighted to inform you about Gadgeteers Summer Reading Challenge 2022. This is a summer reading challenge that encourages all children from 4 to 12 years to read for enjoyment during the school summer holidays. It is run by local libraries and only requires a library card – which is free and can be collected from any local library.

The FUN starts on **Saturday 9 July** at all libraries throughout the Bradford district.

How does it work?

Pop down to your local library, ask to join the Gadgeteers Summer Reading Challenge 2022; show your library card or join the library at the same time & complete a short registration card. You're ready to be a Gadgeteer!

You can read **ANY** library books you like.

Children who join will receive a Gadgeteers kit bag, complete with reading poster to record the books read, stickers and bookmark. Children are encouraged to read between one and 6 books. When you have read 3 books you will receive your second set of stickers and a science-facts paper game. If you complete the challenge by reading 6 books, you'll receive your third set of stickers and a Gadgeteers Certificate and Medal - in recognition of your fantastic reading achievement.

This year's theme –Gadgeteers –developed in partnership with the Science Museum Group, will show children that science; invention and technology is all around us everyday and will inspire us all to be curious and creative.

You can also join us at your local library for our free family-friendly themed events throughout the summer holidays.
