Parking and Driving on Trinity Road / One-Way Queuing Expectations

Unfortunately, a number of parents / carers are putting lives at risk through a total disregard of safe driving and parking at the beginning and end of the school day. This has resulted, on occasions, in complete road blocks caused by cars being left in the middle of Trinity Road whilst parents / carers collect and drop off students.

As a site serving over 1200 students, with many who have complex medical needs, there are times where emergency services require access to the site. This is not possible when dangerous and careless parking is taking place so please ensure that you only park in designated parking areas.

We are in regular contact with Bradford Council to support with traffic management at the start and end of the school day. This also includes staff passing on number plates and photographs of any vehicles who fail to drive or park safely. Bradford Council then have the power to issue fixed penalty notices.

Finally, please ensure that the one-way queuing system at the start and end of the school day is adhered to. We do not have the capacity to supervise parents / carers until the academy gates are opened and therefore, rely on parents / carers to respectfully queue without pushing or jumping ahead. For parents and carers who are collecting students from Reception classrooms, we politely ask that the queuing system continues to be adhered to in order to ensure a calm and safe end to the day.
